CEPAGE DESCRIPTION

Grolleau, or Groslot, has been grown on our hills ides since the $19^{\scriptscriptstyle th}$ century.

It owes its name to the bluish-black color of its berries, reminiscent of the plumage of the Grolle, a local nickname for the Crow.

It is a variety of abundance, capable of very high yields with very large bunches. It is a hardy variety, resistant to spring frost, mildew, powdery mildew and drought. Its very large leaves are only slightly indented, almost round.

With a demanding viticulture, it produces wines of great finesse, low in alcohol, with subtle aromas of rose petals. Spicy on the palate. The light structure offers lively tannins.

VITICULTURE

- Cordon de Royat pruning
- Manual disbudding, lifting and leaf removal
- Manual harvest
- Harvest date : 14 September 2022

VINIFICATION

5-day semi-carbonic maceration in whole bunches

11,5% by vol - 0,1g sugar/L - 2,9g/L total acidity - 0,25g/L volatile acidity - 3,50pH - 22mg/L total SO2

- Ageing for 7 months in stainless steel tanks
- Bottling date : 4 May 2023
- Number of bottles : 3458
